State of Colorado Equine Entry Requirements

- 1. **Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)** issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days prior to entry with all official ID listed. In the address fields please include both the physical address of the horse in your state along with the physical address of the location the horse will be in Colorado.
- 2. Negative EIA Test required within 12 months prior to entry. The date of the test, the results, the lab and the accession number shall be listed on the CVI. Blood samples for EIA testing shall be collected by an accredited veterinarian.
